Theme Question Moving Around Can I easily walk and cycle around using good quality routes? Public Transport Does public transport meet my needs? Traffic And Parking Do traffic and parking arrangements allow people to move around safely and meet community needs? Streets & Spaces Do buildings, streets and public spaces create an attractive place that is easy to get around? Natural Space Can I regularly experience good quality natural space? Play & Recreation Do I have access to a range of spaces and opportunities for play and recreation? Facilities & Amenities Do facilities and amenities meet my needs? Work & Local Economy Is there an active local economy and the opportunity to access good quality work? Housing & Community Does housing support the needs of the community and contribute to a positive environment? Social Interaction Is there a range of spaces and opportunities to meet people? Identity & Belonging Does this place have a positive identity and do I feel I belong? Feeling Safe Do I feel safe? Care & Maintenance Are buildings and spaces well cared for?

Do I feel able to participate in decisions and help change things for the better?








